




Existing 1970













The 2006 HHI

2017-2019 Capital Plan reports \$859,841 in deficiencies throughout the existing 8,000 s.f. City Hall main operational components.





Staff does not recommend spending close to \$2 million to refurbish & expand the existing City Hall. It has exceeded its useful life.

The current space is insufficient and functional needs are limited. An additional 4,601 s.f. of space would cost upwards of a million dollars.

2017's Phase III of the Master Plan offers a new City Hall facility to continue to advance the City of Panama City Beach.






