

RESOLUTION 20-172

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, RELATED TO THE "IRONMAN FLORIDA/IRONMAN 70.3 GULF COAST" TRIATHLONS; AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FRONT BEACH ROAD FROM WEST PIER PARK DRIVE TO POWELL ADAMS DRIVE INTERSECTION ON SATURDAY NOVEMBER 7, 2020 AND SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2020; AUTHORIZING CAREFUL TRAFFIC CONTROL AND EXTRAORDINARY USAGE OF PORTIONS OF FRONT BEACH ROAD, PANAMA CITY BEACH PARKWAY, S.ARNOLD ROAD, AND POWELL ADAMS DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the Ironman Florida is hosting the Ironman 70.3 Gulf Coast, a 1.2 mile swim, 13.1 mile run and 56 mile bike event (the "Event") on Saturday, November 7, 2020 in Panama City Beach: and

WHEREAS, the Events necessitate careful traffic control and extraordinary usage of Front Beach Road from Lullwater Drive to Powell Adams Drive intersection, Panama City Beach Parkway from Lullwater Drive to Powell Adams Drive, Powell Adams Drive, and Front Beach Road from the intersections of S. Arnold Road to West Pier Park Drive in the corporate limits of Panama City Beach.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Panama City Beach that:

1. Front Beach Road from Pier Park Drive to Powell Adams Road shall be closed to vehicular traffic for the Events during the hours of 2:00 A.M. on Saturday, November 7, 2020 until 2:00 A.M. on Sunday, November 8, 2020.
2. During the hours of 2:00 A.M. on Saturday, November 7, 2020 until 2:00 A.M. on Sunday, November 8, 2020, all vehicular traffic shall be rerouted or otherwise controlled on the following roads:

- a. Panama City Beach Parkway from Lullwater Drive to Powell Adams Drive.
 - b. Powell Adams Drive.
3. During the hours of 2:00 A.M. on Saturday, November 7, 2020 until 2:00 A.M. on Sunday, November 8, 2020 Front Beach Road from S. Arnold Road to West Pier Park Drive shall be limited to local traffic.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.

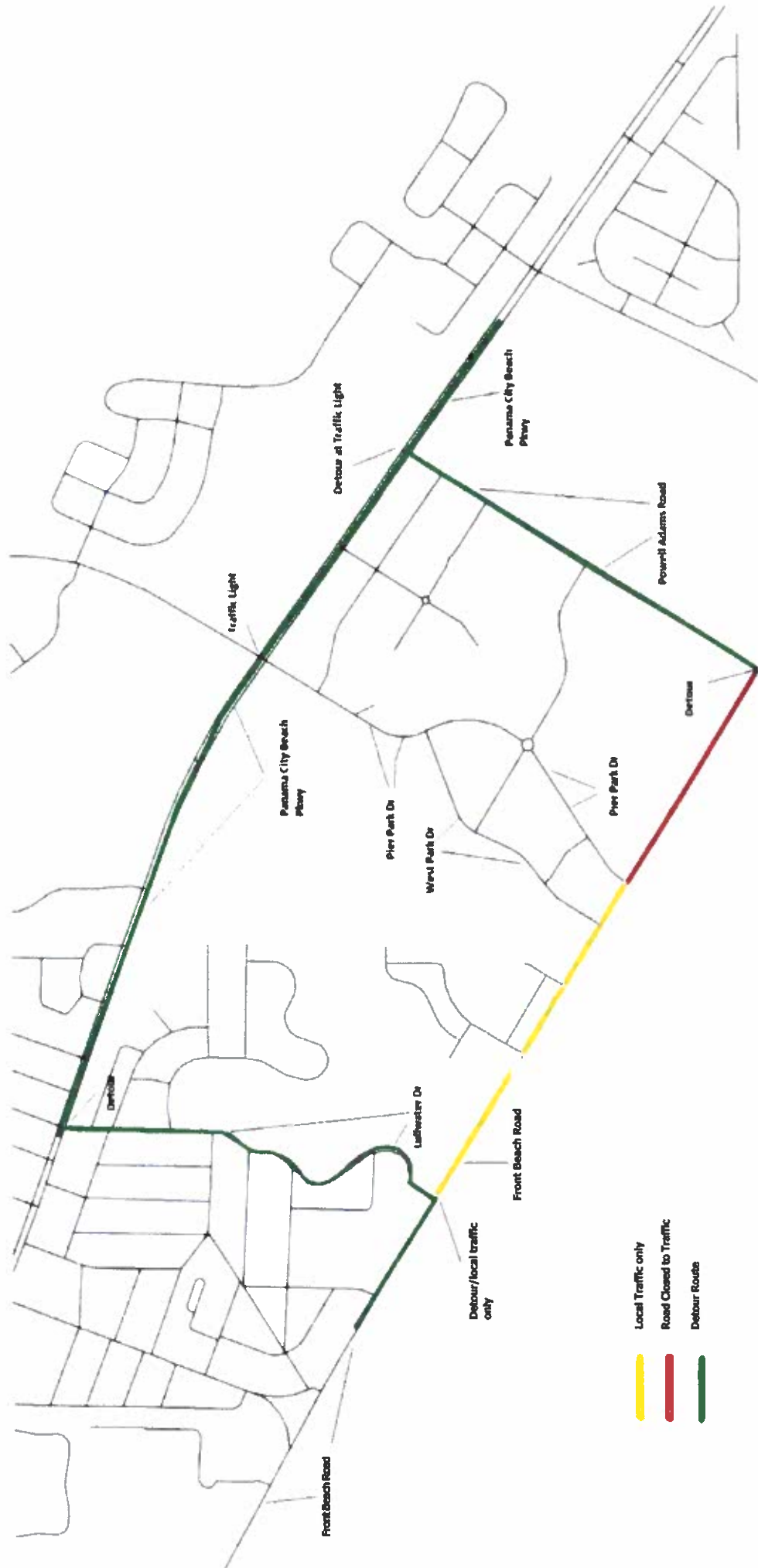
