

RESOLUTION 22-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, RENAMING TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY, THAT PORTION OF STATE ROAD 79 SOUTH OF PANAMA CITY BEACH PARKWAY AS "SOUTH ARNOLD ROAD," AND PROVIDING FOR TRANSITION.

WHEREAS, in April, 2021, the City accepted transfer of the portion of State Road 79 lying south of Panama City Beach Parkway, as part of the redevelopment of that corridor and its intersection with Front Beach Road; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to confirm that this segment of right of way shall, to the extent necessary, be formally named and known as "South Arnold Road".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the north-south right of way lying between Front Beach Road and the Panama City Beach Parkway Road, shall be known henceforth and for all purposes as "South Arnold Road."

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the timing and implementation of this Resolution shall be effected by the City's Community Redevelopment Agency and Public Works Department, in concert with the United States Postal Service, affected law enforcement and emergency services, to minimize any inconvenience and permit overlapping addresses during a reasonable transition period, but to be completed within twelve (12) months.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective immediately upon passage.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED in special session this 10th day of November, 2021.
