2. All officers and agents of the City are directed to pursue the success of this agenda as well as advocate in support of or opposition to legislation that conforms to positions of City Council.


**THIS RESOLUTION** shall be effective immediately upon passage.

**2022-2023 CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH  
FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES**

- Pursue any available federal aid or appropriations for improvements to the transportation system in and around the City of Panama City Beach including, but not limited to, the completion of Philip Griffitts Sr. Parkway from Highway 79 to its eastern terminus, expansion of Panama City Beach Parkway, enhancements to pedestrian and multi-modal transportation throughout the City, and additional projects designed to ease congestion and enhance the transportation experience of the City's residents and guests.
- Pursue any available federal aid or appropriations for improvements to the City's water and wastewater systems including funding for septic-to-sewer conversions and water redundancy improvements.
- Pursue any available federal aid or appropriations for improvements to the City's stormwater system including, but not limited to, offshore outfalls and flooding mitigation.
- Pursue any available federal aid or appropriations for the funding of enhancements of increases in the response time of the City's Fire and Police Departments including, but not limited to, the development of new stations and any other personnel or capital costs associated with continued improvements for those departments.
- Identify and pursue additional opportunities for federal aid or appropriations which will improve the City's ability to meet its strategic priorities as set forth in the City's Strategic Plan 2021-2026.
