A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CAREFUL TRAFFIC CONTROL AND EXTRAORDINARY USAGE OF A PORTION OF MIDDLE BEACH ROAD TO PERMIT THE VISIT PANAMA CITY BEACH IRONMAN 70.3 GULF COAST TRIATHLON ON SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2022; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Visit Panama City Beach IRONMAN Gulf Coast 70.3 Triathlon (the "Event") is scheduled to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2022 in Panama City Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Event necessitates careful traffic control and extraordinary usage of certain sections of Front Beach Road (U.S. Highway 98A) within the corporate limits of Panama City Beach.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of Panama City Beach that during the hours of 4:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Saturday, May 7, 2022, all eastbound vehicular traffic on Middle Beach Road from the western intersection of Middle Beach-Front Beach Road to Richard Jackson Boulevard, shall be rerouted or otherwise controlled in accordance with the map which accompanies this Resolution to accommodate the Event.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

To Whom It May Concern,

In preparation for the 40th annual Visit Panama City Beach IRONMAN 70.3 Gulf Coast triathlon we are in the planning and permitting phase of the event. The event consists of a 1.2-mile swim, a 56-mile bike, and a 13.1-mile run. While the swim and run courses remain the same our bike course has a major change. This year our bike course will utilize Camp Helen St Park to cross under the Panama City Beach Parkway eliminating a crossing of vehicular traffic at the west end of town. We continue to look for ways to improve the event for the community, athletes, residents, and our local emergency services.

For the past several years, we utilized one lane on Middle Beach Road for our runners. We experienced fewer delays and complications using the lane. With that said, we are requesting use of a single lane closure on Middle Beach Road from the Front Beach / Middle Beach merge going east to the R. Jackson Blvd. (See Attachment)

Explanation of work for the lane closure are as followed:

Request the east bound lane (south side of road along the curb) traveling east be closed to allow runners to use the lane for the run course. The event will take place Saturday May 7, 2022. We would require the lane to be closed between the hours of 4am – 5pm to vehicular traffic. One east bound lane will be available for normal traffic and there will be no impact to vehicular traffic traveling west. This is the same course used for the last several years which we received positive feedback with the event operation from the community. We are working closely with the PCBPD, FDOT, and several businesses to ensure we have a minimal impact on traffic within the area of the event at the Edgewater Beach Resort properties at 11212 Front Beach Drive.



We appreciate the continued support of the city of Panama City Beach community, and we are proud to be an intricate part of our community's recovery from Hurricane Michael.






TURN BY TURN DIRECTIONS


- Left out of transition onto Front Beach Road
- Left at Front Beach Road / Middle Beach Road Merge
 - Right onto West Park Drive
 - Left onto Pier Park Drive
- Continue across the Panama City Beach Parkway to the Philips Griffitts Sr

Parkway

- Left onto the Philips Griffitts Sr Parkway
 - Right turn onto Highway 79 North
- Continue north to the Obie Street Turnaround (Approx. .2 mile south of Hwy 20)
 - *Turnaround and continue on Hwy 79 south to Gayle's Trails
 - Right turn onto Gayle's Trails
 - Left turn onto Griffin Boulevard
 - Right turn onto Ashley Drive
 - Right turn onto Panama City Beach Parkway West
- Continue west on the Panama City Beach Parkway to the Publix Supermarket
 - Right into the Publix Parking lot following course around rear of building
- Right turn onto the Panama City Beach Parkway West over the Phillips Inlet
 Bridge
 - Right turn onto Camp Helen temporary bike path
 - Continue on bike path under Hwy 98 to Camp Helen Exit
 - Right turn onto US 98 East (Panama City Beach Parkway)
 - Right onto Front Beach Road
 - Continue on Front Beach Road
 - Right turn at Front Beach Road / Middle Beach Road Merge
 - Right turn into the Edgewater Properties to transition

- Exit transition Left Turn onto the Pedestrian Bridge
- Left Turn onto N Richard Jackson Blvd (loops starts / finishes here)
 - Left Turn onto Maintenance Road
 - Left Turn onto Middle Beach Road
 - Left Turn into the Another Broken Egg Parking Lot
 - Right Turn onto Grand Panama Blvd
 - Left Turn onto Middle Beach Road
 - . Left Turn onto Alf Coleman Blvd.
- Right Turn into Shipwreck Island Parking Lot following course into water park
 - Left Turn onto Middle Beach Road
 - Left Turn onto Dogwood Street
 - Left Turn onto Front Beach Road
 - Left Turn onto Richard Jackson Blvd.
 - Left Turn onto N Richard Jackson Blvd. (Edgewater Villa Entrance)
- Continue straight on N Richard Jackson Blvd. to complete 1st, 2nd, and 3rd loops
 - At the end of the 3rd loop Left Turn onto the Pedestrian Bridge
- Left at the end of the Pedestrian Bridge Left Turn on sidewalk Left Turn under breezeway
 - Right Turn to the finish line
