2. All officers and agents of the City are directed to pursue the success of these priorities as well as advocate in support of or opposition to legislation that conforms to positions of the Council.


**THIS RESOLUTION** shall be effective immediately upon passage.

## **2022- 2023 CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH STATE LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES**

- Pursue any available state aid for the cleaning and de-mucking of Lullwater Lake.
- Pursue any available state aid for improvements to the City's stormwater, water and wastewater systems. In particular, the City seeks funding for septic-to-sewer conversions, water redundancy improvements, and offshore stormwater outfalls.
- Pursue available state aid to ease the impact of the current inflationary economic environment to cover shortfalls in the City's budget related to capital improvement projects including but not limited to the Fire Training Tower Project, the Stormwater Outfall Project, and the Fire Station Project.
- Pursue any available state aid for the planning, design, and construction of additional access roads from Panama City Beach Parkway to Aaron Bessant Park and from Frank Brown Park to Philip Griffitts, Sr. Parkway.
