

RESOLUTION NO. 23-162

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH,
ACCEPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SUPER TUESDAY CITY
REFERENDUM.**

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2023, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1612, proposing two amendments to Article V of the City's Charter; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 23-105, calling a referendum and setting forth two ballot questions; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2023, the City conducted a special referendum seeking approval of the amendments proposed by Resolution 23-105; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2023, the City's Canvassing Board certified the votes given for the referenda specified in that election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council for the City of Panama City Beach hereby approves and accepts the results of the Election as indicated on the **attached** Exhibit A.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendments proposed in Ordinance No. 1612 are void and of no force or effect.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.
