#### **REGULAR AGENDA- DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS**

### \*ITEM 1. ORDINANCE NO. 1620, PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 7.02.03 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE (FRONT BEACH OVERLAY DISTRICTS), FIRST READING.

Mayor Sheldon introduced City Attorney Myers. Mrs. Myers read Ordinance No. 1620 by title only. Mayor Sheldon invited Director Leonard to the podium. Director Leonard reported the Planning Board recently concluded a complete review of Section 7.02.03 of the Land Development Code, the Front Beach Road Overlay Districts. Director Leonard reported the recommended changes were largely grammatical, correcting section references, and improving tables and figures. Director Leonard added discussion by the Board included more significant changes, but none were recommended. Mayor Sheldon thanked Director Leonard.

Mayor Sheldon called for public comment. Hearing and seeing no comment, Mayor Sheldon closed the public comment period. Mayor Sheldon thanked the Planning Board for their efforts. Mayor Sheldon noted this item was available to Council.

### ITEM 2. RESOLUTION NO. 23-170, ACCEPTING SIGNALIZATION AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF POWELL ADAMS ROAD AND FRONT BEACH ROAD.

Mayor Sheldon introduced City Attorney Myers. Mrs. Myers read Resolution No. 23-170 by title only. Mayor Sheldon called for public comments.
