A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, AND EX-OFFICIO AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING AND RATIFYING FORMS OF NOTICES TO TAXING AUTHORITIES AND THE PUBLIC CONCERNING THE **REVENUE** REDEVELOPMENT **ISSUANCE** OF REFUNDING BONDS RELATED TO THE FRONT BEACH PROJECT, REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE GIVING OF SUCH NOTICES, ALL AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 163.346 **PROVIDING** AND AN **STATUTES** FLORIDA IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Panama City Beach, Florida, and *ex-officio* as the governing body of the Panama City Beach Community Redevelopment Agency, as follows:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.

Pursuant to Article VIII, Section 2(b) of the Florida Constitution, and Sections 166.021 and 166.041, Florida Statutes, the City of Panama City Beach (the "City") has all powers of local self-government to perform municipal functions and render municipal services except when prohibited by law. Pursuant to Section 163.358, Florida Statutes, the City, acting ex officio as the Panama City Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (the "Agency"), has all the powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes and provisions of Part III of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Community Redevelopment Act"), except for certain powers not relevant here which vest in the City itself.

SERIES 2006 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT REVENUE BONDS (FRONT BEACH ROAD PROJECT). The form and substance of the public notices to taxing authorities which are attached and incorporated herein, and marked Exhibit A and Exhibit B, are hereby approved and ratified, and the giving of those notices by staff as required by s. 163.346, *Florida Statutes*, is hereby directed or ratified.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

Should any section or provision of this resolution or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder thereof or make the whole invalid.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
