

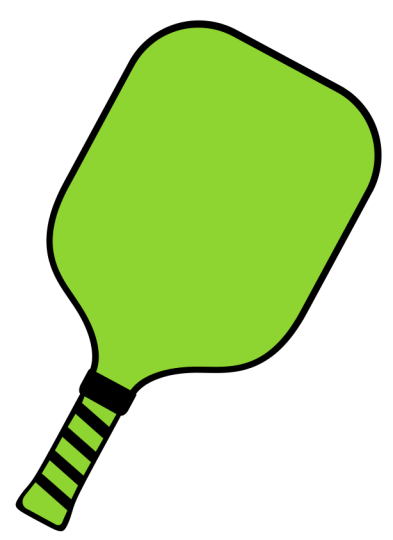
Participants must be 16 and up!!

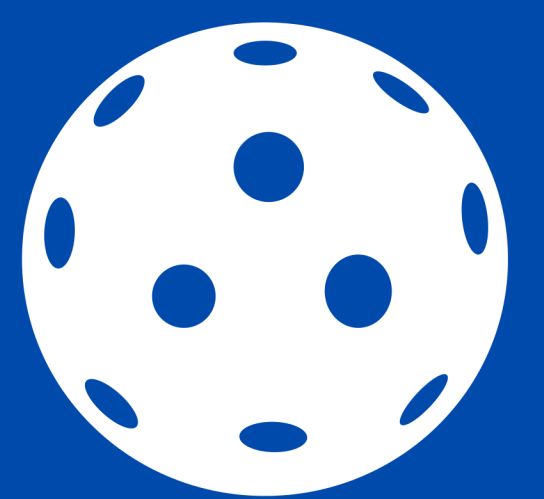
Pickleball Rules:

1. There will only be 24 players allowed in rotation at the Indoor Frank Brown Courts for each playing session January - March.
2. ALL Players must be present to sign in at the start of each playing session. There will be no reserved spots. No one can sign in for another player. NO EXCEPTIONS!
3. Moving paddles will not be tolerated, violators will be removed from the gym.
4. Fighting, arguing, or harassing other participants will result in immediate expulsion and potential trespassing.
5. You must pay to play. No one will be allowed in the gym without payment.
6. The first 12 players who arrive will begin play on the 3 available courts.
7. After the games are completed, the winning team will move to the winning section labeled A. The losing team will move to the losing section labeled B.
8. Participants who arrive after Open Play has started can choose either side A or B and fall in line order with all other participants.
9. Sections A (left side) & B (right side) will feed participants into the open courts as they become available according to the following:
 - a. Section A will start the paddle rotation when the first court is made available.
 - b. Then the next four participants on side B will rotate into the next available court and so on.
 - c. Each side will rotate accordingly winners will go on side A, and losers will go on side B.



Scoring Guide:

- Each game will be played until first team scores 11 points. Winning team must win by 2 points.
- North side (garage door) team for each court will have first serve.
- Beginning serve starts on the deuce side which is the right side facing the net.
- Points can only be scored by serving team.
- When the defending team wins the serve, they then become the serving team.
- After serve has been won, both teammates will have a chance to serve the ball. Deuce player serves first until serve is lost and then the teammate serves until serve is lost.



Punch cards are non-refundable. All punch cards will expire as of May 24, 2024. All unused visits will expire and there will be NO REFUNDS for unused visits. Lost or stolen cards cannot be replaced. A new punch card can be purchased for the set fee of \$30.00. Punch cards must be presented upon entry or the \$5.00 drop-in rate will apply. These rules regarding open play rates are non-negotiable. NO EXCEPTIONS!
