ISS TASK ORDER 2024-07 PCB-017 CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA PCB CONSTRUCTION OBSERVATION ASSISTANCE

Section I. BACKGROUND

The City of Panama City Beach (PCB) has seen significant population and tourism growth which requires the City Staff to grow and oversee the associated utility construction. The City has a need for construction observation assistance to handle all of the projects currently occurring in the City. This Task Order will provide the construction observation services for the City for up to 6 months based on 30 hours per week. The City of PCB has requested that the ISS Team prepare this Task Order to assist with the needed construction observation services.

Section II. SCOPE OF SERVICES, Services during Construction

TASK 1 - SERVICES DURING CONSTRUCTION

a) Provide the City of PCB Utilities Department with hourly construction observation services to meet the City needs on projects. These services are anticipated for up to 6 months based on 30 hours per week.

Section III. SUBCONSULTANTS

The ISS Team does not anticipate the use of subconsultants for this project.

Section IV. <u>CITY RESPONSIBILITY</u>

The City of PCB will review and provide guidance on the projects that the City would like to have the ISS Team provide construction observation.

Section V. DELIVERABLES

The ISS Team will provide the following deliverables to the City of PCB:

1	One (1) electronic copies of the construction observation reports sent to the City of PCB.

Section VI. SCHEDULE

This ISS Team will provide construction observation services as needed on an hourly basis to meet the City required deadlines for up to 6 months. ISS will communicate/coordinate any conflicts that will impact observation services.

Section VII. METHOD OF COMPENSATION

The City of Panama City Beach shall compensate the ISS Team for these construction observation services on a time and expense basis at the rate of \$125.00 per hour. The fee amount for these services is limited to Ninety-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$97,500). At the direction of the City, ISS may be requested to provide additional services. These additional services would be requested and approved by the City of PCB. ISS will invoice the City based on the actual hours and expenses (such as project related mileage) spent to date on this project.
