BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The appropriate officers of the City are authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City that certain Task Order #2024-01 pursuant to the First Amended Master Services Agreement with JRA Architects, Inc., for Professional Architectural Services for Panama City Beach Fire and Police Department, dated November 10, 2022, as amended, related to the design of the Police K9 Training Facility, in the amount of One Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and No Cents (\$139,568.00), in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A and presented to the Council today, with such changes, insertions, or omissions as may be approved by the City Manager and whose execution shall be conclusive evidence of such approval.
- 2. The Council finds and determines that the construction of the Police K9 Training Facility will improve public safety for both residents and tourists. The Council hereby directs that the funds received by the City from the American Rescue Plan Act be used toward the design and construction of this Project.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.

RE: SCOPE OF WORK AND FEE PROPOSAL PANAMA CITY BEACH POLICE K-9 TRANING FACILITY JRA# 24859 C/AC

JRA is excited to submit our fee proposal and scope of work for Design and Construction Services for the new Police K-9 Training Facility to be constructed at North Gulf Boulevard, Panama City Beach, FL.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope shall be further defined in the design phase and be in accordance with the following:

- A. Design single story structure approximately 2,700 square feet in size.
- B. Currently, the building is anticipated to be constructed of reinforced solid grouted CMU exterior walls with structural steel sloped roof, metal deck for missile protection and standing seam metal roof. The facility is to be designed as a Risk Category IV structure capable of withstanding 160 mph winds (using ASCE 7-16 for wind pressure calculations) with enhanced missile protection.
- C. The project will also include a new generator to maintain life safety systems during an event.
- D. Spaces in the design include: (12) dog kennels, office, food and supply storage, dog wash area and restrooms. The exterior will have a paved parking lot with paved street access and a grassed training area secured by fencing.
- E. Along with architectural components, the documents will include Civil, Structural, MEP, Data/Comm/Security and Landscape and Irrigation Designs and Specifications. Services provided will include Design, Permitting, Bidding and Construction Administration.
- F. Geo-technical research and recommendations are included as additional services.
- G. Surveying will be provided by the City.
- H. Services will include initial preliminary submission for building permit services, followup and responses; however, the City will pay all permit submittal and issuance fees and the approved General Contractor shall pull the permit.
- I. Environmental survey, delineating wetlands, identification of endangered plants and animals are not included and will be an additional service.

- J. Throughout the process, we will coordinate input from responsible staff and users, but only as directed by the City's designated Project Manager.
- K. JRA will assist in the bidding process including the advertisement, Pre-Bid Meeting and issuance of any clarifications needed. We will chair the bid opening and assist the City Project Manager with the evaluation of all bids.
- L. During construction, JRA will review submittals, review contractor pay requests, issue clarifications and additional information as required, conduct site visits once a week, participate in the monthly Owner/Architect/Contractor meetings, perform close-out punch lists, review final payment request, review warranties and O&M manuals.
- M. JRA will coordinate all inspections with our consulting engineers to ensure the work meets the requirements of the Florida Building Code. Coordination and scheduling of inspections with the AHJ are typically the contractor's responsibility.
- N. JRA has developed a preliminary production schedule:
 - Notice to Proceed
 - Schematic Design-4 weeks
 - Owner Review-2 weeks.
 - Design Development Documents-10 weeks
 - Owner Review-2 weeks.
 - 60% Construction Documents- 6 weeks. Submittal will include specification Table of Contents and 60% drawings from all subconsultants except Landscape/Irrigation.
 - Owner Review-2 weeks.
 - 95% Construction Documents- 2 weeks.
 - Owners review-2 weeks.
 - 100% Construction Documents-2 weeks.
 - Submit Documents to Building Department.
 - Design Team to incorporate final comments from Owner/Building Official-4 weeks
 - Ready to Advertise for Bid

DESIGN FEES

JRA is basing our proposal on an anticipated area of 2,700 square feet and a budget of 400\$/sf, which extends to an estimated construction cost of \$1,080,000 (excluding site development costs). JRA's proposed fees for providing these services are as follows:
