

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-182**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE USE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR THE FIRE STATION 31 REPLACEMENT PROJECT.**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council finds and determines that the construction of the Fire Station 31 Replacement Project will improve public safety for both residents and tourists. The Council hereby directs that the funds received by the City from the American Rescue Plan Act designated for public safety projects up to the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty-One Dollars (\$2,302,241), be used toward the design and construction of this Project.

**THIS RESOLUTION** shall be effective immediately upon passage.
