## CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER EMERGENCY ORDER 24-02 TROPICAL STORM HELENE

WHEREAS, as of 10:10 p.m. CDT, on Thursday, September 26, 2024, Hurricane Helene made landfall in the northeastern portion of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024, The City of Panama City Beach issued Emergency Order 24-01 declaring a state of emergency in the City of Panama City Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, based on the City's initial damage assessment, I find that the City is able to resume its routine business serving the people of this City.

NOW THEREFORE, I, DREW WHITMAN, CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, in accordance with the provisions of the State of Florida Office of the Governor Executive Order 24-208, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 29 of the City's Code of Ordinances promulgate the following Emergency Order to take effect as provided herein:

- 1. Termination of Emergency Pay. Commencing at 7:30 a.m. CDT, Friday, September 27, 2024, Section 4 of Emergency Order 24-01 is hereby revoked. Nothing herein shall prevent the authorization of Emergency Work outside the jurisdictional limits of the City for the purpose of providing mutual aid to other areas of the State of Florida affected by Hurricane Helene.
- 2. Except as amended herein, Emergency Order 24-01 is reaffirmed and ratified.

THIS ORDER shall be effective immediately upon execution.
