ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 24-45

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF A CITY STREET

WHEREAS, Visit Panama City Beach (the "TDC") has requested temporary road closure of a city street on Tuesday, October 8, 2024 through Monday, October 14, 2024 in Panama City Beach to accommodate the Pirates of the High Seas & Renaissance Festival ("Event"); and

WHEREAS, the Event necessitates careful traffic control and extraordinary usage of portions of South Pier Park Drive within the corporate limits of Panama City Beach; and

WHEREAS, Section 19-50 of the City's Code of Ordinances authorizes the City Manager to restrict the use of streets to reduce the risk of damage to persons and property, to facilitate the efficient use of any street or highway, or to reasonably protect the peace and quiet of properties adjoining any street or highway.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Beginning at 12 o'clock midnight on Tuesday, October 8, 2024 through 6:00 AM on Monday, October 14, 2024 portions of South Pier Park Drive shall be closed for the installation of traffic safety bollards for the Pirates of the High Seas and Renaissance Fest, and all vehicular traffic shall be controlled in accordance with the attached map

THIS ORDER shall be effective immediately upon execution.
